As the Air Traffic Organization's Vice President for Acquisition and Business Services, Dennis DeGaetano is responsible for policies in acquisition contracting and shared business services. This includes information technology, human and labor relations, and legal services.

DeGaetano has been in government service since 1970. He has served in several key executive positions within the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), including Director of the Office of Acquisitions, and Deputy Associate Administrator for Contracting and Quality Assurance. He also served as Program Director for Communications and Aircraft Acquisition, and Manager of the Surveillance, Flight Services and Weather Sensors Division.

In 1996, DeGaetano led an intensive four-month effort to develop the FAA's new acquisition management system for more timely and cost-effective attainment of equipment and materials. He most recently served as the Deputy Associate Administrator for Research and Acquisitions.

DeGaetano earned a bachelor's of science degree in electrical engineering from the Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn and has received many performance awards during his FAA career.
